

## The House Tutoring Lounge: Virtual Tutoring – Instructions for Students

1	Email Link	
	<ul> <li>You will receive an email with a link to your virtual tutoring session</li> <li>Use this link to enter into your virtual tutoring session a few minutes prior to your session so you can set-up your session, microphone, and camera</li> <li>Enter your name and click "Next"</li> </ul>	
2	Student Set-Up & Orientation	
	<ul> <li>Depending on your device, follow the prompts to turn on your camera and microphone</li> <li>Test that your camera, microphone, and speakers are all functioning properly</li> <li>You need to click on the "Test button" to hear the sound in order to check the last box. Will not be able to check the box otherwise.</li> </ul>	You
	<ul> <li>Now you are ready to begin your session. Click "Enter class."</li> <li>Depending on your device, your screen set-up may differ; you may be able to see all of the following features at once, or you may need to toggle between them</li> <li>To view the video conference, click on the video camera or monitor icon</li> <li>To access the chat feature, click on the chat bubbles icon.</li> <li>To access the whiteboard, click on the pencil icon</li> </ul>	
3	Student Tools	
	<ul> <li>Whiteboard Tools (blue circle with a pen on your bottom left)</li> <li>Click to open your tools task-bar</li> <li>Hovering over each tool shows a description of what it does</li> <li>Clicking on each tool shows a sub-menu with further options</li> <li>You can download whiteboards to PDF by using the "Save" tool</li> </ul>	

## Right-side Taskbar

- Lesson Materials
  - The icon with the plus sign opens up "Lesson Materials" where you can upload documents and screen share
  - Screen share
    - You can share another tab or application you have open
      - DO NOT SELECT ENTIRE SCREEN

- When you are done with the screen share click the "Stop sharing button" at the bottom and close the whiteboard tab that is labeled screenshare
- Settings Menu:
  - If having issues with audio/video you can try running a diagnostic

## 4 Student End of Session

When your session is over

- Make sure you have saved any whiteboards you'd like to keep for your records (use the "Save" tool in the tool box)
- Go to upper right, click "Leave Class"
- You have the option to rate the session and provide feedback (this is optional but encouraged)
- You then have the option to do a "Class Review" which will bring up your last session but no tutor will be online and the tools are not available.
- The "Rejoin the Class" is irrelevant as the session will have ended
